
If you haven't yet taken your turn as a board member, this is the time to join! Check out the positions and contact Nigel Leigh with questions.

Board Meeting Minutes—October 7, 2019

Meeting called to order at 6:08 pm Minutes of the September meeting approved as printed [Michael/Rick/Unanimous]

1. Monthly Status Reports:

- Treasurer: The current checking account balance is \$12,291.18. The Paypal balance is \$376.73. Frank met with Tax accountant to work on filings.
- Membership: Gregg suggested that we promote the early registration option as part of the party notice. New membership system was tested by Tod. Tod is hoping to have a laptop and connectivity. for the AGM.
- Weekend Rides: The weekend ride season is over with the Tim Rowe Memorial.
- Newsletter: Michael asked for presidential posting by Tuesday night to get newsletter out by morning of October 9.
- Website: Dennis Pederson requested update to Membership Page and new and corrected links to. Several policies need to be updated. Jim will remove links to policies that need to be updated and correct links.
- · Insurance: No activity.
- Clothing: Hyperthreads shipped the second order and everyone should have received their items. Drew has extra socks that will be available for purchase on at the Annual General Meeting.
- Weekly Road Races: Results were published in the last newsletter and no one has complained so they are considered final and we'll order medals for the fall awards dinner.
- Junior Team: Third race (Mammoth) was cancelled. Trying to recruit coaches that can keep up with kids. Will attend TAMBA annual meeting on Nov 8 to promote the team and help. Drew is working to recruit middle school and high school relationships. Final race is in Truckee on Oct 13 at Tahoe-Donner.
- Fall Century: Dave reported that 21 members rode the whole distance and another 5 did partial

- ride. Nigel suggested looking at alternative Bridgeport meeting location. The club extends a big thank you to Hank Rowe and Curtis Fong for volunteering to host the rest stop at Sweetwater.
- Adopt A Highway: Thomas has confirmed for Oct 12. He'll manage the highway cleanup and Tod will lead the ride afterwards.
- Pinenut Cracker: Brian Dempsey has filed for permits.
- King of Kingsbury Time Trial: Thanks to Allan Biaggi for organizing the 2019 event.
- Mixed Terrain: Report on Weekend. Carlo reported on Bike Monkey plans for next year.
- **Challenge**: Still wrapping up. Working with Frank to get payments made.
- Bike Advocacy: Carlo reported that this is trail building season. Nigel & Jennie worked last weekend. Stanford rock trail work planned. Members should monitor TRT, CVTA, and TAMBA websites for trail building. It's important that cyclists participate to make sure that trail design takes cycling into account. Carlo also reminded us about the NDOT Bike Ped and Trails conference Nov 5-7. TAMBA is holding their end of season party on Nov 8th. We're still awaiting a date for the public meeting to support construction of a Class 1 bike path on Foothill.
- Fall Party: It was agreed that the event will be at CVIC on 11/14. We will invite local bike shops. Fee for guests will be\$20 [Nigel/Tammy/Unanimous]
- 3. Death Ride: Nigel reported on the two meeting that we've held with the Alpine County Chamber of Commerce board. The club presented a proposal to re-start the partnership in order to turn around the Death Ride. Negotiations continue as the Chamber decides how they wish to proceed. However, our proposal is contingent on starting work before the end of October.
- Next Meeting: Monday, November 4, 2019, 6 pm, Lakeside Inn in Stateline.
