

Board Meeting Minutes—October 3, 2022

Meeting held at Jethro's in the Gardnerville Ranchos and by Zoom

Meeting called to order at 6:10 pm

Minutes of the September meeting approved as presented. [Michael I Bruce IUnanimous]

1. Monthly Status Reports:

- **Treasurer**: The current checking account balance is \$20,433.57. The Paypal balance is \$16,334.37.
- Membership: No report.
- Weekend Rides: Weekend rides continuing as weather allows. Leon's birthday ride was well attended.
- Weekly MTB Rides: Five or six members participated in last week's MTB ride. The plan is for Tuesday MTB Rides to continue through the end of October.
- Social Media: Gregg will post for fall meeting and coordinate with efforts to promote social slow paced rides.
- Weekly Road Races: Joseph presented charts showing how race participation has changed over time and how things worked out this year. He is pulling together a report on 2022 race season revenue and expenses for next meeting along with a reimbursement form to cover his out-of-pocket expenses.
- NICA Team: The NICA team has participated in the first three races of the season: North Tahoe, Walker State Park, and Mammoth. Team is doing really well in the freshman and JV categories. The team continues to hold training rides on Monday and Wednesday nights. The last two races of the season are on the 15th and 22nd in Reno.
- Newsletter: Michael needs to get the newsletter out in the next two days for reminder of Oct 6 deadline to RSVP. Presidential Posting and any other content needed ASAP.
- Website: Jim should post the annual meeting.
- Insurance:.No update.

- Clothing: Carlo announced that store for purchasing version of NICA team kit for adult members will be open through October 21.
 Bruce indicated that there have been no recent sales from inventory.
- Fall Century: We had perfect weather. Big thanks to Hank and Dave for hosting the rest stop and to Curtis for donating food. Excellent post-ride Pizza—CG Bar has upped their pizza quality and looks like they will be around next year.
- Adopt A Highway: No report.
- · Pinenut Cracker: No report.
- Challenge: We earned \$174 in jersey sales and are still waiting for invoices from the USFS.
- Bike Advocacy: Carlo reported that on Sat Oct 15 the Carson Valley Trails Association is holding the grand opening of the new section of the Clear Creek Trail: James Lee Loop. There will also be an Alta Alpina ride of the trail prior to the event. Douglas County will soon announce a contractor for updating the county wide trails plan. November 8-10 the trails, transportation, tourism conference will take place in Reno.
- 2. Annual Meeting and Fall Dinner: In September the board voted by email to extend the budget to \$1500 to cover the cost of a Jethro's BBQ dinner. Menu is tentatively BBQ Ribs, BBQ Chicken, Mac-and-Cheese, and Caesar Salad. Allen is traveling so Bill volunteered to work with Jethro's on the details.
- Death Ride Proposal: Bruce put in a significant effort to prepare a response to the Chamber's request for a proposal from the club to be involved in the Death Ride. No decision was made on how to proceed.
- Deputy Secretary: Michael will be traveling and can't attend in person on October 20. Jennie Hamiter will act as Deputy Secretary for the meeting [Michael I Bruce I Unanimous].
