

Minutes of the September meeting approved as presented. [Bill | Michael | Unanimous]

Minutes of the September 23 Special meeting approved as amended to reference "volunteers burned out". [Bill | Nigel | Unanimous]

#### 1. Monthly Status Reports:

- **Treasurer**: The current checking account balance is \$12,851.23. The Paypal balance is \$2,139.46. CDs are currently at \$10,206.63, \$20,263.03 and \$10,689.41. Total \$56,164.76 of which over \$4000 is held for the NICA team.
- **Membership**: Two new members joined the club in the last few days. Allen or Michael will follow up to find out why they joined at this time of year. It may be appropriate to roll their memberships to 2025.
- Weekend Rides: Weekend rides have been well attended due to continuing great weather. Lyn will continue to post rides until the weather turns. Lyn is meeting with the Minden Town Manager meeting on Thursday to discuss the proposed plans for a joint event with the Douglas-Dolphins.
- Weekly MTB Rides: Rides continue to be well attended. Jennie and Jim continue to post rides for a couple more weeks.
- Social Media: No report.
